- Overall intent is to accommodate all those who will be attending. However, if the attendee size is too large to ensure social distancing, the FLC will be used for overflow.
- > All attendees will enter through the main sanctuary foyer doors
- > A greeter will take each person's temperature before entering CBC
- Once inside CBC's facilities, a facemask is required at all times. If an attendee does not have one, one will be provided.
- To ensure social distancing of 6 feet between each family unit/household, the ushers will seat each family unit/household.
- Once seated, attendees are requested to not to move to another seat/location. However, if necessary, any move must be coordinated with the help of an usher.
- There will be praise songs during the service. At that time, everyone will be welcome to join in as long as they keep their facemasks on.
- After the service during the recessional, Barb and her family members will receive people in the foyer by the welcome center desk. Crowd control stanchions will be positioned to create a minimal physical barrier.
 - Ushers will release several family units/households at a time after the service to ensure social distancing and to prevent any bunching-up of people. Those in the sanctuary will be released first, followed by those who are in the FLC. Attendees, please be patient.
 - As Barb and family members receives the attendees, hugging or handshakes are NOT allowed. An elbow bump is acceptable. To keep the receiving line moving, attendees will be requested to minimize any conversation.
 - After greetings with the family, attendees are requested to exit the sanctuary foyer immediately and NOT stay around to socialize or fellowship.
 - If anyone needs to leave earlier and will not go through the receiving line:
 - From the sanctuary, they will be asked to exit the side door of the sanctuary and exit the building using the southwest door. An usher will guide you.
 - From the FLC, they are to exit using the breezeway doors and then either exit through the doors by the office or through the doors by the nursery.
