
## Guidelines to Reopen Chinese Baptist Church

In accordance with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and the Governor's Office recommendations concerning best practices to reopen houses of worship, these 10 guidelines will be utilized by Chinese Baptist Church as we reopen our campus for worship.

1. **Practice Social Distancing**: Please maintain a distance of at least 6 feet between you and the next person at all times (e.g., while in any line and in the common areas). In the sanctuary during worship service, please maintain 3 seats between you and the next person. Members of the same Household or that have been "Sheltering in Place" together may sit together.





2: Worship Services: English service has been moved up 15 minutes and will start at 9:45 a.m. to allow for cleaning before the start of the Cantonese worship service. Cantonese & Mandarin at regular time.

3. High-Risk Individuals: All individuals that fall within the high-risk groups as defined by the CDC are encouraged to stay at home and worship online.





4. **Nursery**: Our nursery and ALL other ministries will not reopen at this time.



5. **Masks**: masks are mandatory and are to be worn by attendees. If you do not have a mask, CBC will have extra masks available.




6. Hand Sanitizing Stations: Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout our campus.



7. Your Health: If you are coughing, sneezing or running a fever, please do not come to church, even if it is due to allergies. Temperatures will be scanned during entry.

8. **Restrooms**: Chinese Baptist Church will monitor restroom capacity to enable social distancing. Depending on the size of the restroom facility, only 1 to 2 people will be allowed at a time unless the people are members of the same household or have been "Sheltering in Place" together.





9. Hand to Hand Items: No items will be passed among attendees at Chinese Baptist Church, including offering plates, print materials, or other worship items. Offering can be dropped off in the wooden boxes throughout the church, be made online, or via text. Additionally, attendees should practice touchless greeting (no handshakes or hugs).

10. **Sanitation**: Surfaces (e.g., door handles, countertops, etc.) will be sanitized between worship services.
