"Difficult Days on the Guadalupe River"

As you know, the weekly "WORDS FROM A PASTOR" are not always directed toward specific individuals or issues currently affecting CBC. Sometimes, these musings are simply random thoughts offered for reflection, with the hope that you'll come to know this pastor a little better. That being said, there are times when the circumstances of our world give rise to emotions and concerns that shape what is written.

This past Sunday, as CBC gathered to celebrate the United States' Independence Day, I must confess that it was difficult to balance the holiday's celebratory spirit with the emotional struggle over the devastation experienced by those in nearby Kerr County. On one hand, the joy of the freedoms we enjoy in this country—especially the freedom to believe and practice our faith—is truly amazing. Yet, we must also remember to lift up in prayer those nearby who are overwhelmed by circumstances far beyond their control or comfort zone.

The pain of losing a child is never easily borne. Spiritualizing our words of concern for those living along the Guadalupe River who have lost loved ones may not be immediately helpful to those who are hurting. Rather than share examples of similar losses we may have endured, may we instead simply acknowledge that the grief is real and deeply painful, and quietly pray for those in mourning.

Perhaps, before you sleep, you'll take a few moments to share your heart with the Lord—offering your concern for these fellow Texans who are confused, grieving, and struggling.
