Pastor's Word by Pastor Donald Gardner

"May Christ's Sacrifice for You Guide Your Days"

If any of us are to grow as Christians, we must become learners. That means we must be sensitive to the situations and people that surround us on a daily basis. Sometimes, I have good days with this, and sometimes I have bad days! Before you laugh at me, consider that you too may not be perfect in your skills in this area. Maybe we can pray for each other in this journey of faith and service.

At 15, I became enthralled with the ministry of a man named Arthur Blessitt. He was a unique evangelist from California who walked and pulled a huge wooden cross as he traveled across the states and countries he visited. His cross was 12 feet tall and, while on rollers, the beams were not light. It was rather "extreme" to use this approach to bring attention to the message of Christ in people's lives, but it did accomplish the goal of getting people to ask spiritual questions about Jesus—His life, suffering, and sacrifice for us. By pulling this cross over 40,000 miles and into hundreds of countries as a testimony of Christ's love for mankind, Blessitt left a powerful witness for his Lord. Obviously, we too must ask: What kind of witness are we leaving with our lives?

One evening in Dallas, after attending a meeting led by this man, I returned home and found myself on my knees praying for the salvation of my older cousin. For me, such behavior was unusual, but the Holy Spirit of God seemed to overwhelm my interests to the point that I wanted to block out the distractions of this world and do something significant—so I prayed! As I wept over Danny's lostness and considered the consequences of his not following Jesus, I prayed for God's guidance and for the soul of this dear relative. My heart was broken in a new and profound way, and it marked the beginning of a new life journey with my Lord.

It is my prayer for you that you don't allow the distractions and excuses of our society to keep you from having a similar fellowship with the Lord Jesus. Please don't look for reasons to avoid the sensitivity of the Holy Spirit in your life. Instead, look for reasons to have fellowship with your Savior. Get on your knees in a quiet place, think of others who urgently need direction and purpose in their lives, and pray for them. Such modeling comes from our Lord.
