<u>Ephesians: But Now – Made Us One in Christ</u> Oct. 23, 2022 Sermon by Pastor Oleg Xu

<u>Main Point:</u> Christ died to create a new community at peace with the Living God and with one another. Chinese Baptist Church is to remember our standing as one in Christ, who is our Peace. And we must strive to be in unity, in harmony, with fellow believers/church members, for the sake of the gospel and the glory of God.
