5. How does Scripture speak towards "foolish" living?

6. What does "submit" mean in verse 21?

Reflective Questions:

- Paul urges the Christians to expose what is dark. How might the Christian church do this today? What are some challenges that prevent this? What are some ways to encourage this?
- 4. Who is someone this week you can encourage, remind, or teach in light of the Gospel this week?

3. What gets you "drunk" at this moment in your life? What distracts you? What consumes you to the point where you cannot live toward Christ?
