- How does Paul introduce the armor of God? What does it ultimately do? (see vs. 10)
- 3. The Greek word for "whole armor" (panoplia) refers to the complete equipment of a fully armed soldier. Why is this important?
- 4. What are these "deceitful schemes" Paul is referring to? (see 4:14; 1 John 2:18, 22; 4:3)

Reflection Questions:

- 1. How does Paul portray the Christian life? How might this change how we see our everyday life?
- 2. Who are the enemies of the Christian?
- 3. Why can't the Christian merely rely on material human resources?
- 4. How should a Christian begin each day if this passage is true?
- How might CBC take this passage seriously in our budget? How we disciple? How we program? How we educate our people?
