Peace and Love of the Father to US!

Ephesians 6:17-24 (CSB)

<u>Main Point:</u> As we put on the Lord Jesus Christ, the armor of God, we have now been fully equipped and empowered to share the good news with the lost. His peace and love will be with us as we stand up for Christ!

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is the significance of the following to evangelism and to gospel living?
 - a. Salvation helmet
 - b. Sword of the Spirit
- 2. Why does Paul ask for a prayer to share Christ, when he was still in the prison?
- 3. What does the peace and love of God the Father and Christian brotherhood in the church have in common?

Write a short prayer asking the Triune God to help you in your fear of sharing the gospel?

Who are your prayer supporters when it comes to you witnessing to the lost?

What is one takeaway from the Epistle to the Ephesians as you apply it to your life?

Application:

- a. Commitment to the Scriptures repels Satan and opens the eyes of the lost to receiving Christ
- b. Constant communication with our Father leads to opportunities to share gospel with boldness
- c. Connect daily to the Father's peace and love through faith in His resurrected Son
