OUR ETERNAL RICHES IN CHRIST (Chapter 1-3) Blessings involving God the Father (1:4-6) Blessings involving God the Son (1:7-12) Blessings involving God the Holy Spirit (1:13-14)

Spiritual Blessings Involving the Father:

- I. CHOSEN BY GOD (1:4)
 - A. Chosen -
 - 1. Election=Eklegomai -
 - B. The Time of this choice (v.4)
 - 1. "...before the foundation of the world", 1 Peter 1:20
 - C. The Objects of this choice
 - 1. One view:
 - a. Individual (only certain select ones have been chosen)
 - b. Dependent solely on God's gracious and mysterious will
 - c. Unconditional and final
 - 2. Another view:
 - a. Individual (certain select ones have been chosen)
 - b. Based upon foreknowledge of those who would respond to the gospel and persevere in the faith
 - c. Unconditional and final, in the sense that God already knows who will persevere to the end
 - 3. "...chose us in Him (i.e. Christ, v.4a)
 - a. Is it general or corporate?
 - b. Is it the Body of Christ, the church as a whole, which God chose for His divine and gracious purposes He planned to carry out in Christ?
 - c. 2 Peter 1:10
 - 1. Israel as a nation chosen by God to receive blessings
 - 2. Individually, Israelites had to "make their calling and election sure"
 - D. The Purpose of this choice
 - "that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love"
 "Holy"
 - b. "Without blame" -
 - c. "In love" Eph 5:1-2, 1 Pe 2:9

- II. PREDESTINED BY GOD (1:5-6a)
 - A. Predestined = Proorizo -
 - 1. Who was it that God "predetermined" beforehand?
 - B. The Subjects of God's predestination -
 - 1. "Us" (v. 4a)
 - 2. What was it that God "predetermined"?
 - C. The Purpose of God's predestination
 - 1. "Adoption as sons" (v.5a)
 - 2. Why did God "predetermine" this?
 - D. The Basis of God's predestination
 - 1. "According to the good pleasure of his will" (v.5b)
 - a. God was pleased and wanted to do that
 - b. By His divine will he has made it possible in Christ
- III. ACCEPTED BY GOD (1:6)
 - A. Accepted = Charitoo -
 - 1. Those in Christ are 'highly favored' in God's sight, Lk 1:28
 - B. The Basis upon which we are accepted
 - 2. "In the Beloved"
 - 3. All these blessings, including acceptance, are "IN" and "BY" Christ:
 - 1. God chose us "in Him (Christ)", v. 4
 - 2. God predestined us to adoption as sons "by Jesus Christ", v.5
 - 3. God has made us accepted "in the Beloved (Christ), v.6
 - 4. It is by our being "in" Christ that we privileged to be "highly favored" by God and showered by these wonderful blessings

What should our reaction be to all of this?

- To praise the Triune God for His glorious grace
- You are family member to the God of the Universe
- You are in the Beloved, you belong to the living Christ
- You can be fully, 100% assured today and for eternity safe
- Live with confidence that He will always love you and keep you in His grace
