Walk Worthy of Your Calling

Ephesians 4:1-6 (CSB)

Main Point: Christians are to live in a manner worthy of our calling, which means living in visible, loving harmony with other Christians. It must be based on the attributes of God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
